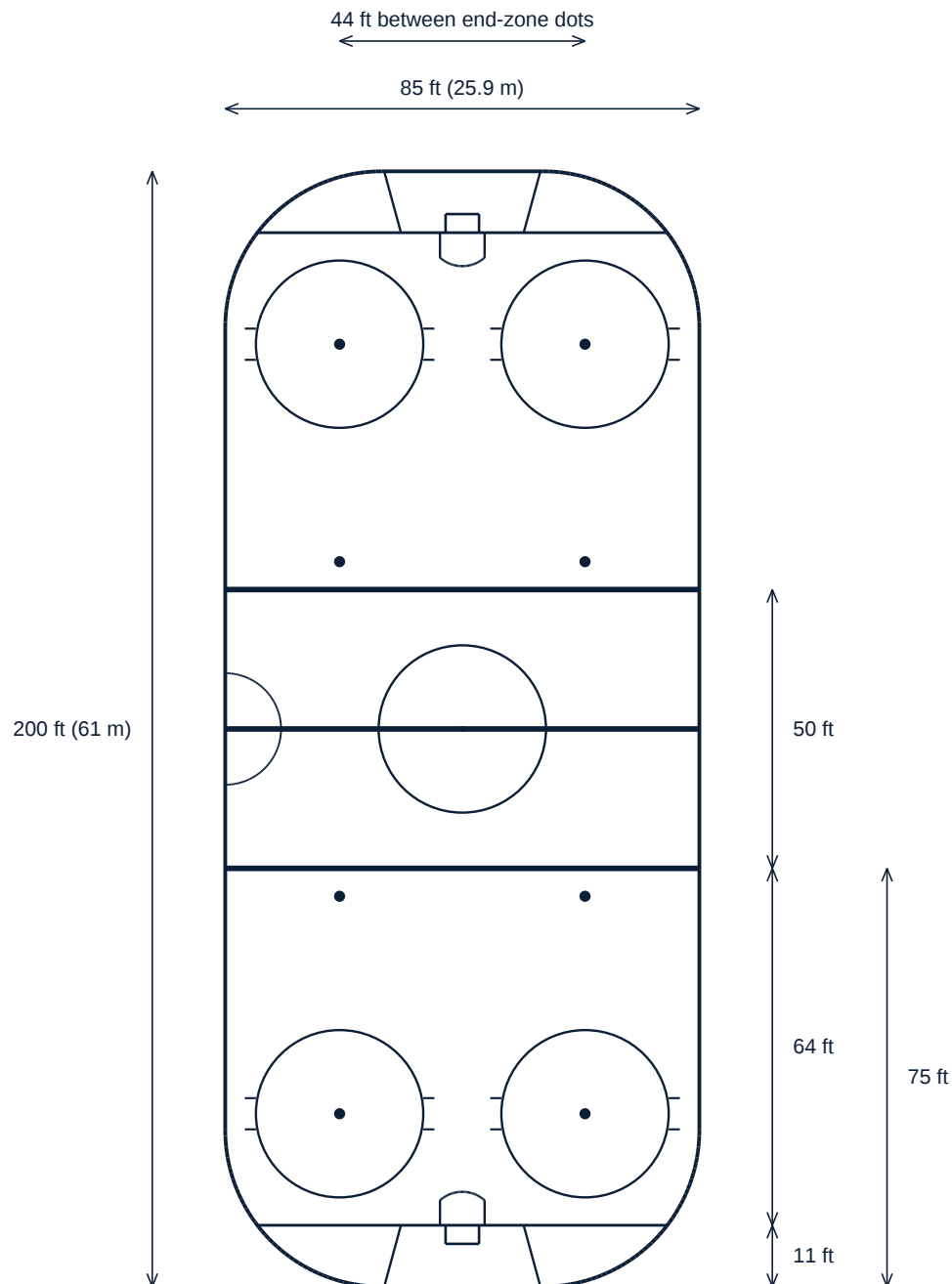


NHL Hockey Rink Dimensions

200 x 85 ft -- NHL Rule 1



Corners 28 ft radius; goal lines 11 ft from the end boards; blue lines 75 ft from the boards, 50 ft apart; all three lines 12 in wide except the 2-in goal line
Face-off circles 15 ft radius; end-zone dots 20 ft from the goal line and 22 ft either side of centre; neutral-zone dots 5 ft from each blue line
Crease 8 ft wide, 4 ft 6 in deep to a 6-ft-radius arc; goal 6 ft x 4 ft, 40 in deep; goaltender trapezoid 22 ft at the goal line, 28 ft at the boards
Referee's crease 10 ft radius at the timekeeper's bench; boards 40-48 in high
Same rink for the AHL, ECHL, NCAA and USA Hockey; NCAA and USA Hockey rinks may not mark the trapezoid
