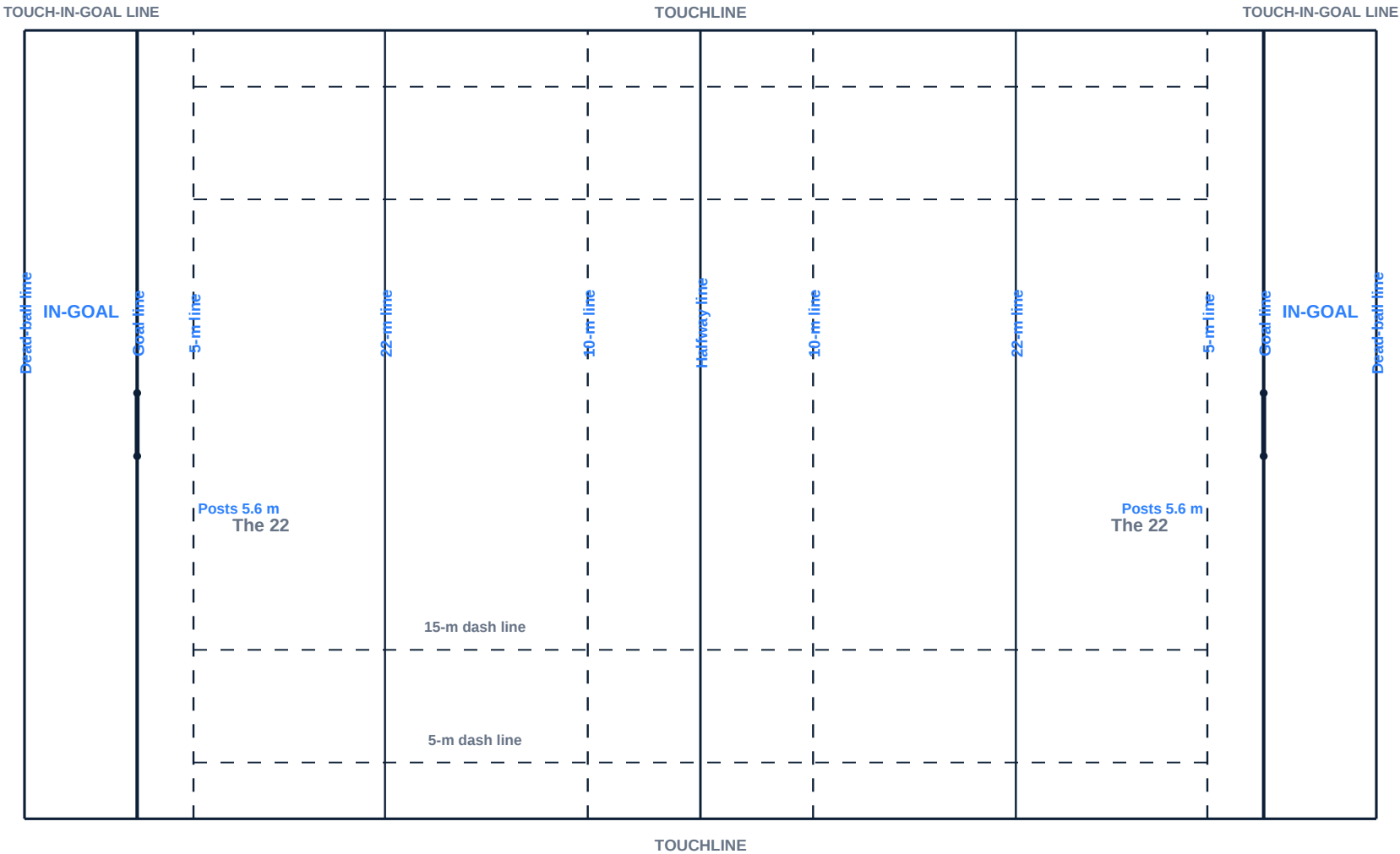


Rugby Pitch Diagram -- Labeled

Every line and area on a World Rugby pitch, named



Solid lines: goal lines, 22-metre lines, halfway. Dashed: the 10-metre lines, the 5-metre lines in front of each goal line, and the 5 m and 15 m dash lines in from touch. The in-goal is where tries are scored -- between the goal line and the dead-ball line, 6 to 22 m deep. The 22 is the defending team's territory inside its own 22-metre line. Lineouts are thrown between the 5 m and 15 m dash lines; a kick-off must reach the receiving side's 10-metre line. Rugby sevens is played on this same pitch.
