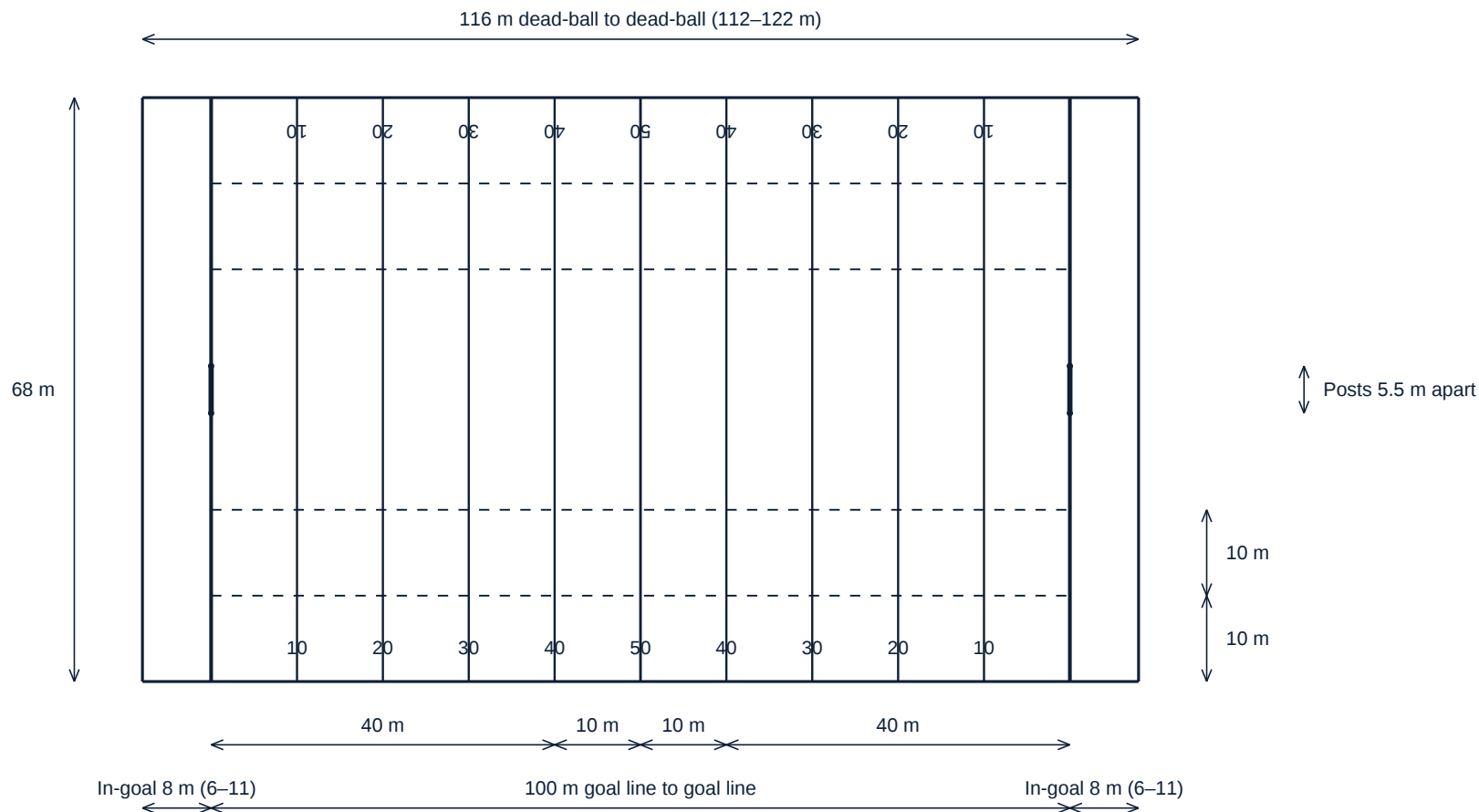


Rugby League Field Dimensions

100 x 68 m -- RFL / NRL Laws of the Game



Field of play 100 m by 68 m -- a fixed size, not a range -- with in-goal areas 6–11 m deep
A solid line every 10 m, numbered from each goal line to the 50 at halfway; the 40-metre lines are usually painted red for the 40/20 kick
Broken lines 10 m and 20 m in from each touchline mark where scrums and tap restarts are set after the ball goes out
Goal posts 5.5 m apart with the crossbar 3 m above the ground; professional posts stand around 16 m tall
