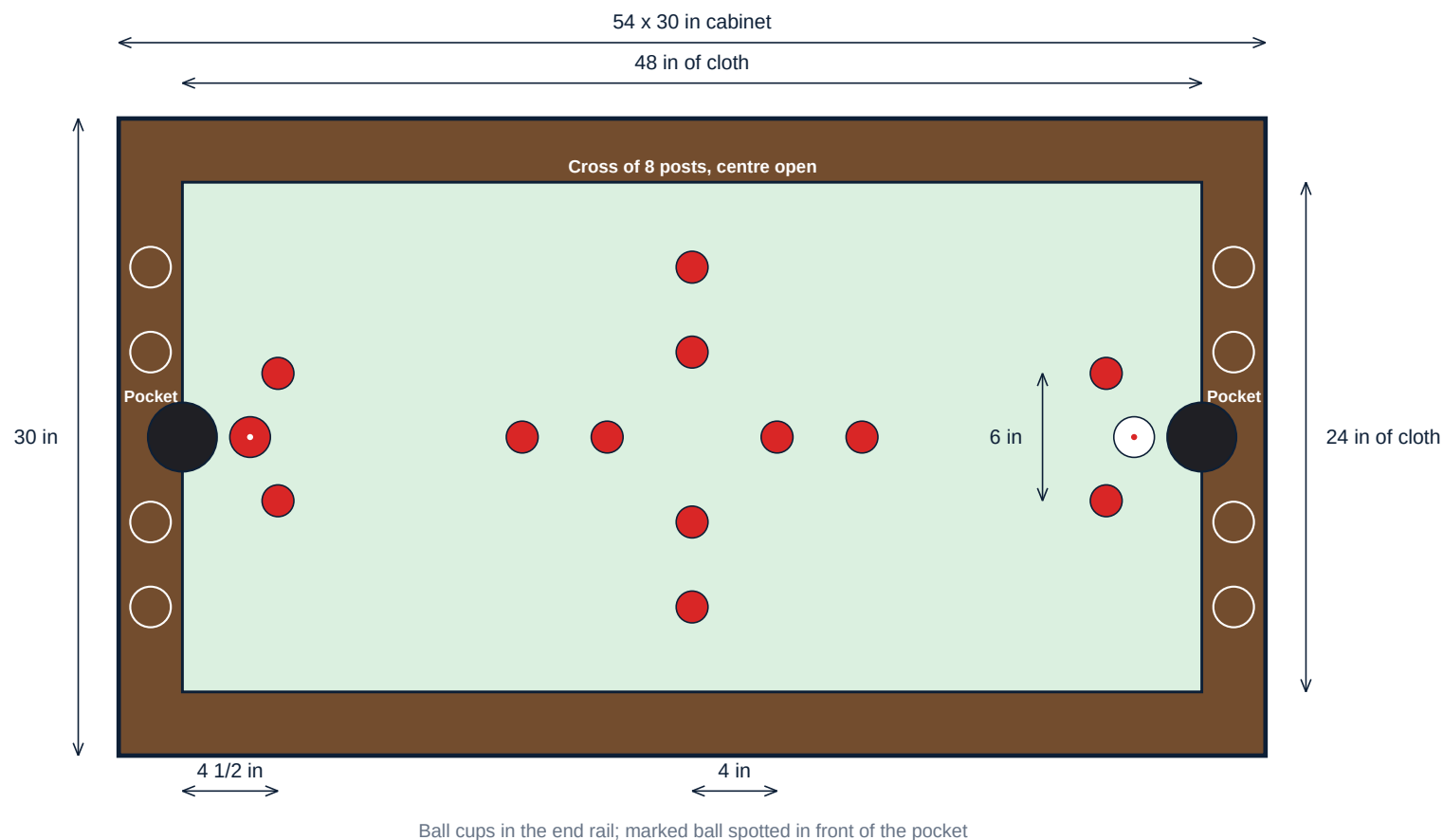


Bumper Pool Table Dimensions

54 x 30 in rectangular table -- pockets, posts and ball cups, typical layout



Rectangular tables: about 54 x 30 in overall with 48 x 24 in of cloth; vintage coin-op and some slate tables run a few inches larger. Octagon tables 48-54 in across the flats. Playing surface 30-32 in off the floor

Two pockets, one in the middle of each end rail; twelve posts -- eight in a cross at the centre with the middle left open, and two guarding each pocket. Some tables have sixteen

Five red and five white balls, 2 1/8 in, one of each marked with a spot; short cues, usually 48 in (42 in for tight rooms)

Room: playfield plus two cue lengths each way -- 12 x 10 ft with 48-in cues, 11 x 9 ft with 42-in cues; an octagon wants about 11 1/2 ft square
