

Baseball Darts Score Sheet

Nine innings plus extras for up to six players

Player	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	E1	E2	R

Inning 1: three darts at the 1. Inning 2: three darts at the 2 ... through the 9. Single = 1 run, double = 2 runs, treble = 3 runs; anything else is an out that scores nothing.
Most runs after nine innings wins. Tied? Play extra innings (E1 at the 10, E2 at the 11) until one inning breaks the tie. Total the R column as you go.
Also played on a baseball dartboard: hits and outs by the segment landed in, three outs an inning, nine innings a side.
Kids' version: count the bull as a home run (4) in any inning, and let doubles and trebles count as singles until they can aim for them.
