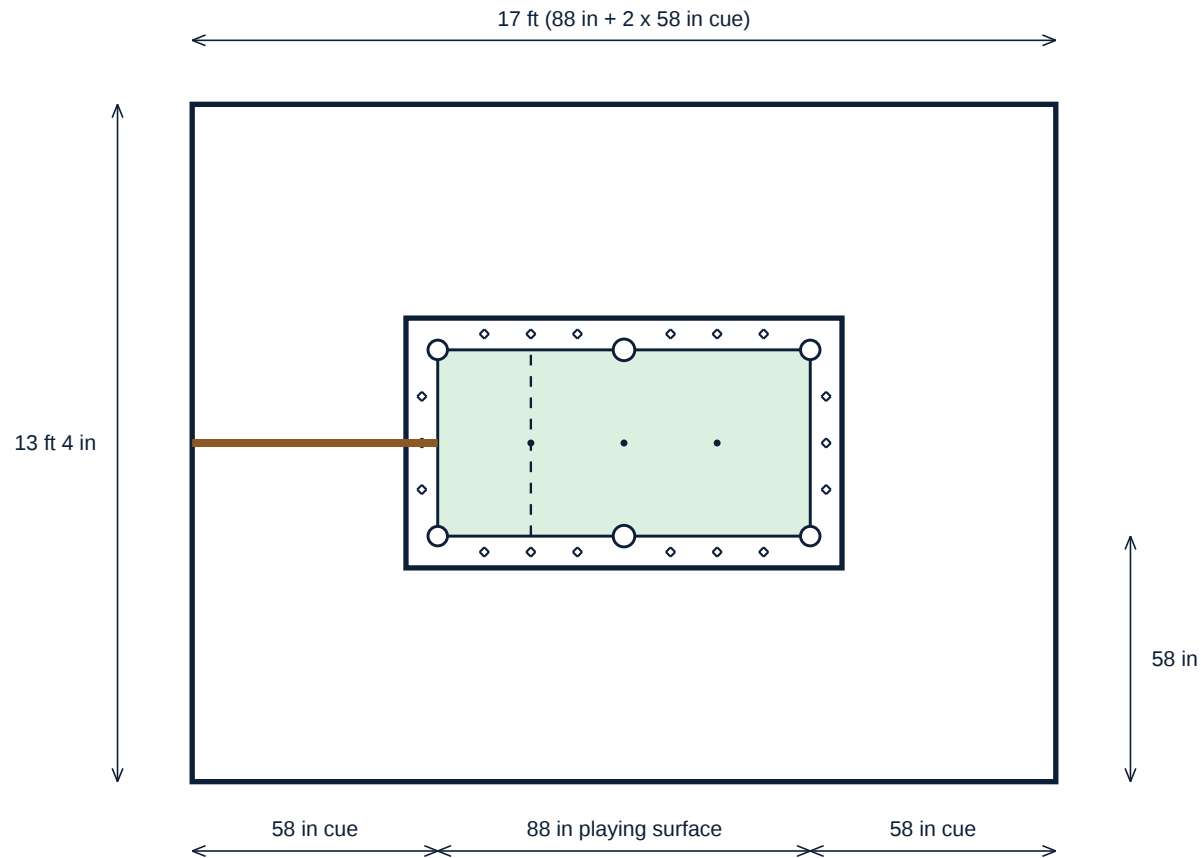


Pool Table Room Size

An 8 ft table with 58-in cue clearance -- and the formula for any table



Minimum room for any table = playing surface + two cue lengths each way: 7 ft 16 ft 2 in x 12 ft 11 in, 8 ft 17 ft x 13 ft 4 in, 9 ft 18 ft x 13 ft 10 in with 58-in cues
A 52-in cue takes a foot off each dimension, a 48-in cue about 20 in. Furniture, radiators and posts count as walls; a pocket in a corner needs the same reach as a rail
Add a few inches beyond the formula so the cue butt clears the wall on a full-stroke shot; figures follow the Brunswick and Olhausen room charts
