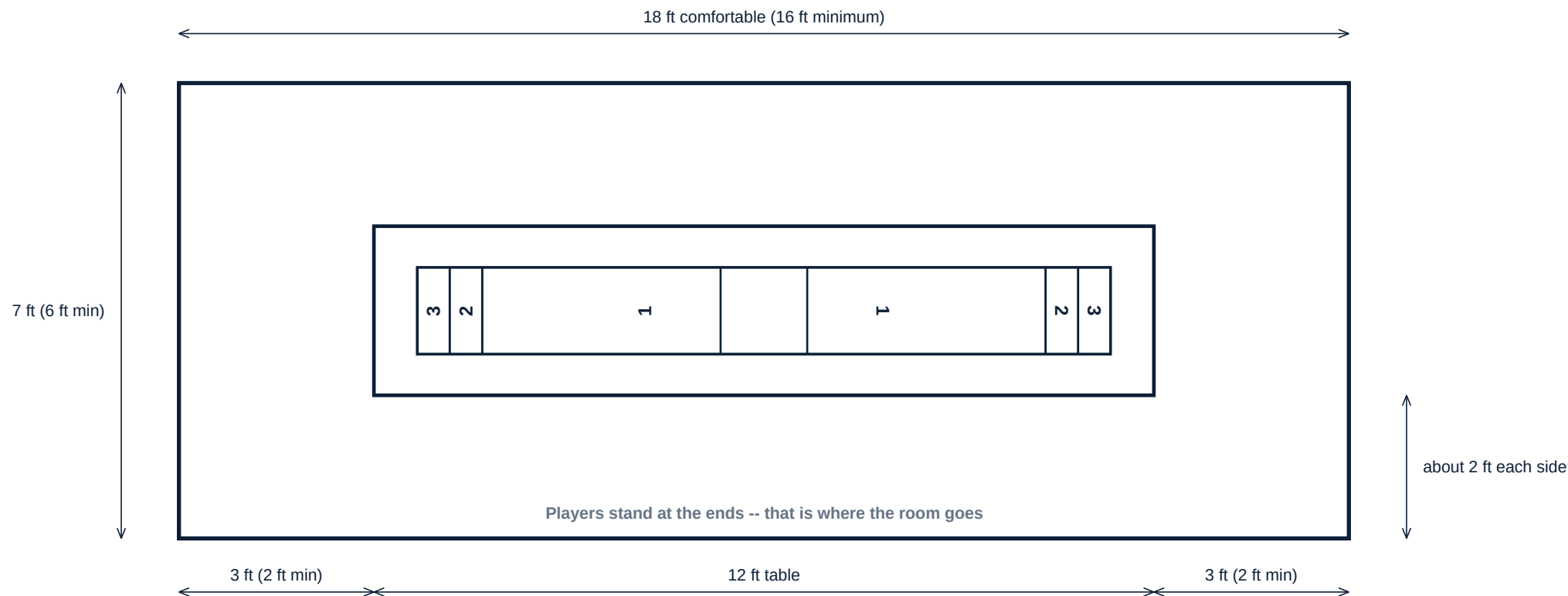


Shuffleboard Table Room Size

A 12 ft table with its clearances -- and the rule for every other length



Rule of thumb for any length: room = table + 4 ft minimum (6 ft comfortable) by 6-7 ft wide. Add space at the ends before the sides

A 9-ft table fits a 13 x 6 ft space, 14 ft needs 18 x 6, 16 ft needs 20 x 6, the 22-ft regulation table 26 x 6 -- see the size chart sheet

Doorways and stairs matter more than the room: cabinets ship in sections on longer tables, but a one-piece 12-ft board still needs a straight path in
