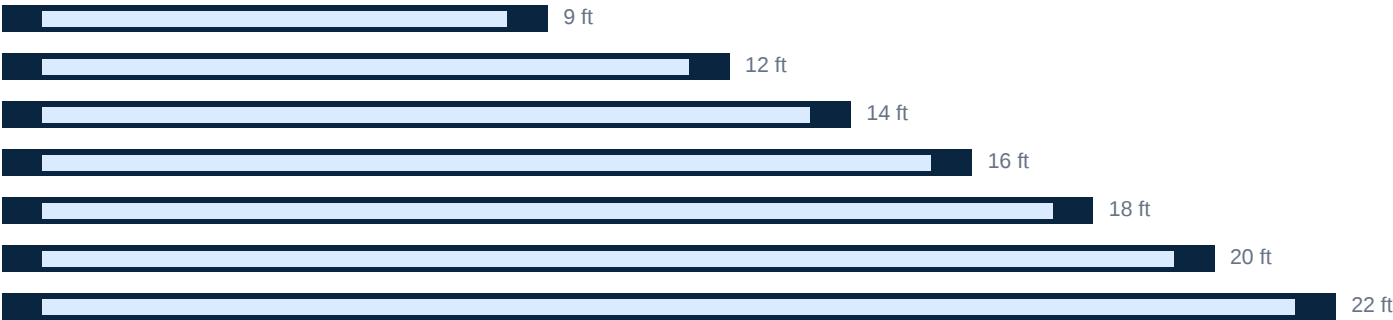


Shuffleboard Table Sizes

9 to 22 ft -- playfield length and the room each needs

Table	Playfield	Playfield width	Minimum room	Comfortable	Notes
9 ft	7 ft 8 in	16 in	13 x 6 ft	15 x 7 ft	Apartments and small bars; plays fast
12 ft	10 ft 8 in	16 in	16 x 6 ft	18 x 7 ft	The best-selling home size
14 ft	12 ft 8 in	16 in	18 x 6 ft	20 x 7 ft	Best seller with more room to play position
16 ft	14 ft 8 in	16 in	20 x 6 ft	22 x 7 ft	Feels like a full table in a long game room
18 ft	16 ft 8 in	20 in	22 x 6 ft	24 x 7 ft	Club and bar length
20 ft	18 ft 8 in	20 in	24 x 6 ft	26 x 7 ft	Club and bar length
22 ft	20 ft 8 in	20 in	26 x 6 ft	28 x 7 ft	Regulation -- tournaments and leagues

TO SCALE



Playfield length is about 16 in less than the cabinet (a 12-ft table plays 10 ft 8 in). Minimum room = table length + 2 ft at each end x 6 ft; comfortable = + 3 ft at each end x 7 ft

16 in is the usual home playfield width; 18-20 in on club and regulation tables. Height 30-32 in. A table can sit about 1 ft from a side wall

Regulation for tournaments is 22 ft x 20 in (Table Shuffleboard Association); 12 and 14 ft are the best-selling home sizes
